

Trends over the last 10 years

- The number of superyachts under construction/on order worldwide was approx. 81 ten years ago, compared with 445 this year. (Yacht Report)
- The average size of motor yacht being built now is said to be around 60 metres (cost if ordered today, being between EUR40 million and EUR70 million). In 1990 a 60m motor yacht would have been amongst the largest built.
- Private motor yachts account for 80% of today's superyacht fleet.
- Most are built in Northern Europe, but demand has boosted output in New Zealand, and newer entrants are China, Russia and Turkey.
- A 4-year waiting list to have a supervacht built is about average.
